SUBJECT: Major Budget Realignment Request

PURPOSE:

To review and respond to the major budget realignment request items for the reporting month of June 2013.

BACKGROUND/HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE:

This item is being presented in accordance with Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) Policy 02.100.02.

As a part of the monthly consent calendar, the State Board reviews and authorizes budget adjustments affecting the current fiscal year's appropriation. Some adjustments require State Board action; others are reflected for information purposes only.

Budget Amendments (State Board Action Items):

Budget Amendments are required whenever an increase is requested for the current budget appropriation at the budgetary program and appropriated fund level (i.e., General, Special, Federal or Reimbursable Funds). The following are types of adjustments shown in the Major Budget Realignment (MBR) Request that require State Board approval:

- Tying in to grant awards received (Increases) – Special Fund and Federal Fund amounts included within the original appropriation are based upon estimated receipts. When the fiscal year begins and the actual grant or a more accurate estimated amount is higher, an adjustment is made to reflect the full amount.
- Carryover from prior fiscal year – Federal fund carryover results from the federal fiscal year overlap of three months as compared to the State fiscal year, and from the Tydings Amendment, which allows some federal formula grants to be spent for an additional 12 months. These adjustments are required to make maximum use of the grants.
- Transfers between budgetary programs – The allocation of the funds between the budgetary units and between programs within the budgets are based upon original estimates available when the budget is prepared. During the fiscal year it may become necessary to adjust this allocation.

- Tying in to the approved Indirect Cost rates – On occasion, the actual indirect cost rates received may be materially different from the rates used in preparation of the budget. In those cases, it may be necessary to reallocate the assessment against non-State funds.
- Reorganizations – Organizational changes that cross budgetary programs are reflected by a budget amendment.

Other Budget Adjustments (State Board Information Items):

The following types of adjustments are reflected in the Major Budget Realignment Request and are shown for information purposes only:

- Recognition and Subsequent Release of Withheld Allotments – Withheld Allotments are funds appropriated in an agency's budget that have been held back pending the resolution of one or more contingencies identified in the annual Budget Bill. The funds are not made available to the agency until the identified condition(s) have been met.
- Deficiency Appropriations – Once Deficiency Requests are approved by the General Assembly as part of the Budget Bill, the approval is shown for information purposes.
- Tying in to grant awards received (Decreases) – The opposite of the adjustment type described above under Budget Amendments. These are decreases to the appropriation level in the Agency Budget (i.e., MSDE) to recognize lower than budgeted Grant Awards or Special Fund attainment.

The Major Budget Realignment (MBR) Request has several sections:

- The cover memo indicates whether there are items requiring approval or information items.
- The Synopsis of Current Pending items (if any) – On an item-by-item basis this explains and justifies any items presented for State Board approval. These items are identified as numbers (i.e., Item 1, Item 2, etc).
- The Summary of Current Pending Items (if any) – This summary schedule reflects the amount by budgetary program of each of the approval items.
- The Synopsis of Information Items (if any) – On an item-by-item basis this explains and justifies any items presented for State Board information. These items are identified as letters (i.e., Item A, Item B, etc).
- The Summary of Information Items (if any) – This summary schedule reflects the amount by budgetary program of each of the information items.
- The MBR Schedule – This schedule presents a great deal of information regarding the overall budget status and the effects of the adjustments being presented in the current month. The schedule presents the budget by Budgetary Unit (i.e., Headquarters, Aid to Education, Funding

for Educational Organizations, and Children's Cabinet Interagency Fund), by budgetary program and by appropriated fund. The columns reflect the following information:

- The first column reflects the program and fund titles.
- The second column, "Original Appropriation," reflects the original appropriation level for the fiscal year.
- The next two columns, "Approved Adjustments," reflect adjustments that have already been made to the budget. The "DBM" column reflects adjustments made to the official appropriation level. The "MSDE" column includes those adjustments as well as decreases that would not be reflected in the official appropriation.
- The following two columns entitled, "Approved Appropriation," reflect the sum of the original appropriation and the approved adjustments for DBM and MSDE, respectively.
- The next two columns reflect pending budget amendments:
 - "Prior" shows pending amendments that have been before the State Board in an earlier month but have not yet been approved; and
 - "Current" shows the items being presented to the State Board in this MBR for the approval period.
- The final column shows the Information Item adjustments included in the current MBR.

ACTION:

We request permission to process the following authorized transfers between Programs and Divisions in the amount of **\$2,075,266** (transfers net to zero) as listed in Items 1 through 14.

SYNOPSIS
CURRENT PENDING ITEMS
For the Reporting Month of June 2013

ITEM 1

This amendment requests the transfer of Special Fund Appropriation in the Headquarters budget in the amount of \$30,000 to the Division of Certification and Accreditation from the Division of Rehabilitation Services (DORS) - Headquarters. The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE) collects a \$10 processing fee for each initial and renewal teacher licensing certificate. Based on FY 2013 revenues to date, the budgeted appropriation for the Certification Fees Program is lower than the revenue attained. Since the revenues and expenditures need to balance at year end, we need to increase the appropriation. These funds will be used to replace out-of-warranty computers. The transferred appropriation in the DORS - Third Party Recoveries program is being reduced to tie into the spending plan for FY 2013 and will not adversely impact the program's objectives.

ITEM 2

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation in the Headquarters budget in the amount of \$4,950 to the Division of Career and College Readiness from the Division of Student, Family and School Support. These funds are available under the Career and Technical Education - Basic Grants to States program. The U. S. Department of Education (USDE) awarded this grant to MSDE to develop more fully the academic, career, and technical skills of secondary and postsecondary students who elect to enroll in career and technical education programs. These funds will be disbursed to qualified recipients. The transferred appropriation in Division of Student, Family and School Support is being reduced to reflect the spending plan for FY 2013 and will not adversely impact the program's objectives.

ITEM 3

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation in the Headquarters budget from the DORS - Disability Determination Services to the DORS - Headquarters in the amount of \$300,000 as well as to the DORS - Workforce and Technology Center in the amount of \$500,000. These funds are available under the Rehabilitation Services - Vocational Rehabilitation Grants to States program. USDE awarded this grant to MSDE in order to: (1) assist in operating comprehensive, coordinated, effective, efficient and accountable programs of vocational rehabilitation and (2) assess, plan, develop and provide vocational rehabilitation services for individuals with disabilities, consistent with their strengths, resources, priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities, and informed choice so they may prepare for and engage in competitive employment. These funds will be used to cover costs related to medical service support and telecommunications. This transferred appropriation allows the agency to meet expected obligations for these programs and does not adversely affect operations in DORS - Disability Determination Services.

SYNOPSIS
CURRENT PENDING ITEMS
For the Reporting Month of June 2013

ITEM 4

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation in the Headquarters budget in the amount of \$500,000 to the DORS - Office of Blindness and Vision Services from the DORS - Disability Determination Services. These funds are available under the Rehabilitation Services - Independent Living Services for Older Individuals Who are Blind program. USDE awarded this grant to MSDE in order to: (1) provide independent living services that improve or expand services for older individuals who are blind and (2) conduct activities to help improve public understanding of the problems of these individuals. These funds will be used to cover costs related to medical service support. This transferred appropriation allows the agency to meet expected obligations for these programs and does not adversely affect program objectives in DORS - Disability Determination Services.

ITEM 5

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation within the Headquarters budget from the DORS - Disability Determination Services to the DORS - Client Services in the amount of \$448,000 as well as to the Division of Blindness and Vision Services in the amount of \$130,000. These funds are available under the Supplemental Security Income program. The Social Security Administration (SSA) awarded this grant to MSDE to ensure a minimum level of income to persons who have attained age 65 or are blind or disabled, and whose income and resources are below specified levels. These funds will be used to cover costs related to medical services support. This transferred appropriation allows the agency to meet expected obligations for these programs and does not adversely affect program objectives in DORS - Disability Determination Services.

ITEM 6

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation in the Headquarters budget from the Division of Student, Family and School Support to the Division of Business Services in the amount of \$29,818 as well as to the Division of Instruction in the amount of \$16,500. These funds are available under the Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities-National Programs. USDE awarded this grant to MSDE in order to: (1) enhance the Nation's efforts to prevent the illegal use of drugs and violence and to promote safety and discipline for students at all educational levels; and (2) support programs that reduce alcohol abuse among secondary school students. These funds will be used to cover costs related to educational training and central support. The transferred appropriation in the Division of Student, Family and School Support is being reduced to reflect the spending plan for FY 2013 and will not adversely impact the program's objectives.

SYNOPSIS
CURRENT PENDING ITEMS
For the Reporting Month of June 2013

ITEM 7

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation from the Division of Student, Family and School Support in the Headquarters budget to the Children at Risk program in the amount of \$17,000 in the Aid to Education budget as well as to the Division of Business Services in the amount of \$885 in the Headquarters budget. These funds are available from a grant awarded under the Education for Homeless Children and Youth program. USDE awarded this grant to MSDE in order to ensure that all homeless children and youth have equal access to the same free, appropriate public education available to other children. The Education for Homeless Children and Youth program provides assistance to States to: (1) establish or designate an Office of Coordinator for Education of Homeless Children and Youth; (2) develop and carry out a State plan for the education of homeless children; and (3) make sub grants to local educational agencies (LEAs) to support the education of those children. These funds will be used to cover costs related to educational grants and central support. This transferred appropriation in the Division of Student, Family and School Support is being reduced to reflect the spending plan for FY 2013 and will not adversely impact the program's objectives.

ITEM 8

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation in the Headquarters budget to the Division of Business Services in the amount of \$1,463 from the Division of Student, Family and School Support. These funds are available from a grant awarded under the Grants to Local Educational Agencies program. The U. S. Department of Education (USDE) awarded this grant to MSDE in order to help local education agencies provide extra instruction in high-poverty schools to those students who are failing or are at risk of failing to meet the challenging State academic achievement standards. These funds will be used to cover costs related to central support. The transferred appropriation in the Division of Student, Family and School Support is being reduced to reflect the spending plan for FY 2013 and will not adversely impact the program.

ITEM 9

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation within the Headquarters budget in the amount of \$1,123 to the Division of Business Services from the Division of Student, Family and School Support. These funds are available from a grant awarded under the School Improvements Grants. USDE awarded this grant to MSDE in order to: (1) support competitive sub-grants to local educational agencies (LEAs) that demonstrate the greatest need for the funds and the strongest commitment to use the funds; and (2) provide adequate resources in order to raise substantially the achievement of students in their lowest-performing schools. LEAs seeking funding to serve such schools must implement one of four school intervention models: turnaround model, restart model, school closure, or transformation model. These funds will be used to cover costs related to central support. This transferred appropriation allows the agency to meet expected obligations for these programs and does not adversely affect operation in the Division of Student, Family and School support.

SYNOPSIS
CURRENT PENDING ITEMS
For the Reporting Month of June 2013

ITEM 10

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation within the Headquarters budget in the amount of \$8,417 to the Division of Business Services from the Division of Assessments and Accountability and Data Systems (DAADS). These funds are available under the Grants for State Assessments and Related Activities program. The USDE awarded this grant to MSDE in order to: (1) support the development of the additional State assessments and standards of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), as amended; and (2) support the administration of those assessments already developed by States or to carry out other activities related to ensuring that the State's schools and local education agencies are held accountable for results. These funds will be used to cover costs related to central support. The transferred appropriation from the DAADS program is being reduced to reflect the spending plan for FY 2013 and will not adversely impact the program.

ITEM 11

This amendment requests the transfer of Federal Fund Appropriation in the Headquarters budget in the aggregate amount of \$2,101 to the Division of Business Services from the Division of Assessments and Accountability and Data Systems (DAADS). These funds are available from National Assessment of Educational Progress. MSDE was granted these funds to conduct continuing assessment and to provide reliable data pertaining to the student's knowledge and abilities in various subject areas such as mathematics, reading, science and writing. These funds will be used to cover costs related to central support. The transferred appropriation from the DAADS program is being reduced to reflect the spending plan for FY 2013 and will not adversely impact the program.

ITEM 12

This amendment requests a transfer of General Fund Appropriation within the Headquarters budget in the amount of \$46,000 from the Division of Business Services to the Division of Academic Reform and Innovation in the amount of \$30,000; to the Division of Special Education/Early Intervention Services in the amount of \$6,000; and to the Division of Career and College Readiness in the amount of \$10,000. These General Funds currently exist within MSDE's budget as a result of the prudent monitoring of General Funds throughout the fiscal year. The transferred appropriation from the Division of Business Services program is being reduced to reflect the spending plan for FY 2013 and will not adversely impact the program.

ITEM 13

This amendment requests a transfer of General Fund Appropriation within the Aid to Education budget in the amount of \$2,009 to the State Share of Foundation Program from the Compensatory Education program. This adjustment is necessary to fund final enrollment adjustments.

ITEM 14

This amendment requests a transfer of General Fund Appropriation within the Aid to Education budget in the amount of \$37,000 to the Teacher Development Program from Aid for Employee Fringe Benefits Program. These funds are needed to cover the costs associated with Teacher Stipends in FY 2013.
