## NOTICE OF NON-COMPLIANCE WITH MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT

Dear Mr. Newcomb:

On November 30, 2011, the Superintendent of Dorchester County Public Schools, Dr. Henry V. Wagner, Jr., filed a Maintenance of Effort Certification Statement (Attached) with the Maryland State Department of Education. Pursuant to Education Article §5-213 and based on the dollar amounts reflected on the certificate, I find that Dorchester County is not in compliance with its FY 2012 maintenance of effort requirement. Specifically, the maintenance of effort level amount for FY 2012 is \$17,231,888. Dorchester County failed to meet that target. Dr. Wagner has certified that the net local appropriation was \$16,481,888.

If the county disputes this finding of noncompliance, it may send to me within 30 days of the issuance of this notice of memorandum setting forth the basis for disputing this finding. I will refer the matter to the State Board of Education which will make the final determination.
