What is the Special Milk Program (SMP)?

The SMP provides cash reimbursement for half-pints of milk served to eligible children in schools, child care centers, summer camps, and other non-profit organizations. This program is funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and is administered by the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE).

Benefits

- Increased milk consumption for children
- Cash reimbursement for milk
- Training and technical assistance, educational workshops, and other resources are available

Who Can Participate?

Children 21 and under at participating schools.
Children 19 and under at other types of organizations.

How are Sponsors Reimbursed?

The two rates of reimbursement, set by the USDA, are for paid half-pints and free half-pints.

Monthly reimbursement is based on:

- the number of half-pints served to eligible children multiplied by the rate of reimbursement
Or
- The average cost of all milk purchased.

Eligible Program Sponsors

Organizations eligible to participate in the SMP include:

- Public or private nonprofit schools
- Public or private nonprofit residential summer camps
- Private, nonprofit day cares and organizations
- Some homeless shelters
- Those sites not participating in another USDA funded meal program
