**101 Payment Policy and Procedure.**

**101.01 Rate of Payment.** The Division shall pay for authorized services at a rate equal to the lower of:

- a. The Provider's customary charge;
- b. The maximum rate established in this "Division of Rehabilitation Services Fee Schedule", which incorporates by reference the fees established by Medicare for medical or surgical procedures (109% of the *Medicare Fee Schedule* for the Baltimore Metropolitan area).

**101.02 Provision of Services.** The use of the *Medicare Fee Schedule* for medical and surgical fees does not mean that all procedures included in that schedule may be arranged, provided, or paid for by the Division. Policy associated with the provision of certain services prevails including established restrictions, requirements for referral for Medical Advisor consultations, reporting requirements and management review and approval, as appropriate. (Refer to RSMs II and III for policy related to provision of services.)

**102 State Contracts.** Contracts for the purchase of certain goods have been established between vendors and either the State Purchasing Bureau or the Division of Rehabilitation Services (see RSM III, Section 1009). Goods on contract must be purchased through the contract. For information about computer hardware and software and closed Circuit Television (CCTV) systems on contract refer to the AT site on InDORS.

**103 Hospital Fees.** Fees for hospital inpatient and outpatient services are those set by the Maryland Health Services Cost Review commission (HSCRC).

**104 Exceptions to Published Fees.** Exceptions to the established fees require submission of a *Fee Exception/Approval Request* (RS-3h) through supervisory

channels to the Director, Disability Determination Services; Director, Office of Field Services; Director, Office for Blindness and Vision Services; or Director, WTC as appropriate (see RSM III, Section 1008.03).

**105 Fees.** To assist staff with the use of certain standard and routine medical evaluation and treatment services, a listing of services or procedures and approved fees follows, including medical services, psychotherapy and psychological testing, and physical medicine and allied medical services. In addition, fees are provided for services which are unique to the Division or otherwise not reflected in the *Medicare Fee Schedule*, including dental services, and vocational and allied services. All fees listed are per visit/session (time not defined) unless specified.

Note: If a medical/surgical service is needed which is not listed on the following tables, OFS and OBVS staff shall contact the Director, Office of Field Services; WTC staff shall contact the WTC Assistant Director for Administration, as appropriate, to establish the correct CPT code and fee. The DDS Medical Relations Office will handle fee exceptions for DDS.

**Fee Updates.** Fees based on Medicare rates are updated annually, and are effective April 1 of the year. Current updates are effective **4/1/09**.

**CRP Fees**

Following are fees the Maryland Division of Rehabilitation Services (DORS) pays for services provided to applicants and eligible individuals by Community Rehabilitation programs.

**Description of Services and Fee Structure:**

**Career Assessment Services (CAS).** The CAS model includes 5 types of assessment services: itemized; exploratory; community based; comprehensive and focused. A two-tiered fee structure is based on qualifications of staff and certification of the agency:

**Job Coaching Services.** Job Coaching may be provided outside of “supported employment,” and within supported employment on an individual, enclave or mobile crew basis. A three-tiered fee structure has been established based on costs incurred by the provider:

**Job Development, Placement and Retention.** The JDPR program is offered by many community providers and includes outcome payments for referral, placement and

retention. The rate is the same for all providers approved to provide JDPR, and all providers approved to provide JDPR provide all three elements:

Acquired Brain Injury Program. **DORS is the lead agency in implementing the Governor's Employment Initiative for Individuals with Acquired Brain Injuries (ABI Initiative) in collaboration with other interested stakeholders and entities. Primary features of this Initiative are an assessment protocol, intensive service delivery and provision by DORS of both short-term and ongoing supports needed in the workplace. It also includes a research component conducted by the University of Maryland Rehabilitation Program. Specific DORS counselors have been identified to provide services to all ABI Initiative participants.**
