Joseph L. Wright, MD, MPH is Senior Vice President and head of the Child Health Advocacy Institute, a newly established center of excellence at Children's National Medical Center in Washington, DC, the nation's third-oldest children's hospital. In that capacity, Dr. Wright provides strategic leadership for the organization's advocacy mission, public policy positions and community partnership initiatives. Academically, Dr. Wright is Professor and Vice Chairman in the Department of Pediatrics, as well as Professor of Emergency Medicine and Health Policy at the George Washington University Schools of Medicine and Public Health. Dr. Wright serves on several advisory bodies including the Board of Trustees of the National Children's Museum, as an Obama administration appointee to the Pediatric Advisory Committee of the Food

and Drug Administration (FDA), and as an advisor to the Sesame Street Workshop. He has also served national appointments to study committees of the Institute of Medicine and the National Quality Forum. Dr. Wright regularly delivers invited expert testimony before Congress and state and municipal legislative bodies, has made numerous media appearances and lectures widely to both professional and lay audiences.
