#### **Submission Criteria:**

- Level of creativity
- Originality
- Relevant to the contents of the Blackboard site or could be seasonal in nature
- Innovative
- Appropriateness
- Follow format and size requirements
- Must be original work - no copyrighted material (music, images, etc.) or trademarks
- All student work will be Creative Common licensed as Attribution-Non-commercial-NoDerivs

#### **Digital Media Specifications:**

1. Submissions may be in the form of **graphic designs, videos, audio clips, digital illustrations, or photographs**. Feel free to use any available design applications/programs, but please be sure the product is submitted in a .png, .jpeg, .mp4, .wmv, .avi, or .mp3 file format.
2. Video and audio should be no longer than 2 minutes in length
3. Digital images may be in the form of a banner, a rectangle or square image, or an icon
  - Images may have to be cropped and should be of medium resolution

- Digital artwork must be at least two-dimensional and electronically generated
